Multiple-choice: This is a type of assessment where students select the best answer to a question from a list of four or five alternatives. A multiple-choice assessment often consists of a large number of questions and can be used to cover the entire curriculum in the course.

Another way to answer the question is to remember that the distance between two numbers on the number line is equal to the absolute value of the difference of the two numbers. For example, the distance between -1 and 1 is 2 and the distance between 10 and 1 is 9 . The correct answer is Choice A, Figure 5
