Litmus paper is a type of pH paper made by treating the paper with natural dyes from lichens. The litmus test is performed by placing a small drop of sample onto the colored paper. Usually, litmus paper is either red or blue. Red paper turns blue when the pH is alkaline, while blue paper turns red when the pH turns acidic.

Wet 2 pieces of litmus paper. A litmus test works best with gases that are dissolved in water (an aqueous solution). To achieve this on a small scale, you only need to wet the paper with water. When the gas touches the wet paper, some of it will dissolve into solution right on the test strip.
