Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart's Piano Sonata No. 8 in A minor, K. 310 / 300d, was written in 1778. The sonata is the first of only two Mozart piano sonatas in a minor key (the other being No. 14 in C minor, K. 457). It was composed in the summer of 1778 around the time of his mother's death, one of the most tragic times of his life.

Mozart Piano Sonata no. 8, K. 310 The Piano Sonata no. 8, K. 310/300d, written in 1778, is a work in three movements. A typical performance takes about 22 minutes. This is the first of only two Mozart piano sonatas to have been composed in a minor key (the other being the K. 457 in C minor).

Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart's Piano Sonata No. 9 in D major, K. 311 / 284c, was written on the composer's stay in Augsburg and Mannheim in November-December 1777, and is contemporaneous with his Sonata K. 309 (Mozart wrote his Sonata K. 310 in the summer of the following year, in Paris). The three sonatas K. 309-311 were published as a set 'Opus IV' in about 1782, by Franz Joseph Heina in Paris.
